ABSTRACT

THE ESTABLISHMENT OF EGYPT TO ISRAEL IN CONNECTING THE PALESTINA CONFLICT - ISRAEL IN THE GOVERNMENT OF ABDEL FATTAH EL-SISI

This research raises the title of Egypt's foreign policy towards the Palestinian-Israeli conflict during the time of President Fatah El Sisi. This study uses the approach of foreign decision-making Willian D. Coplin. The method used in this study is qualitative using qualitative descriptive data analysis techniques. The results of this study found that the attitude of Egypt during the time of President Fattah el Sisi tends to side with Israel related to the Israeli-Palestinian conflict due to the influence of the domestic political situation of Egypt, economic conditions, and military influence, as well as the international context that Egypt is facing. But the most influential factor is the Egyptian military, because President Fattah el Sisi is from a military group, as well as the military interests that are still within the Egyptian government.
