The Regency/City harmony ratio in North Sumatra shows that the District / City of Serdang Bedagai and North Nias. The dependency ratio of regency / city regions in North Sumatra shows a dependency tendency in the central government. The ratio of income growth in regencies/cities in North Sumatra is a positive trend.
