This study aims to determine the Regional Financial Performance in the six cities of Central Java Province. The average degree of fiscal decentralization ratio fiscal of the six cities amounting to 23.69% is included in the medium criteria because it is in the interval of 20.1% -30%. The average the independence ratio of the six cities in Central Java Province was 42.34% still in the low category and had a pattern of consultative relationships. The average the efficiency ratio of six cities in Central Java Province amounted to 97.07% which was included in the criteria of being less efficient because it was still in the interval of 90-100%. The average the dependency ratio of the six cities in Central Java Province is 61.52%. The average the harmony ratio of the six cities in Central Java Province is 20.28%. The results of the causality test between regional financial performance and economic growth did not occur in the causal relationship between regional financial performance and economic growth in the six cities in Central Java.
