

Evaluation of City Minimum Wage of Yogyakarta City on the Amount of Decent Living Needs (KHL) in Yogyakarta City in 2019

Abstract

The main objective of this study is to determine the suitability of the Decent Living Needs (DLN) to the Minimum Wage Regency/City (MWR) in Yogyakarta City determined by the Government in 2019 using a formula, and to find out whether there is a difference between the Decent Living Needs (DLN) with Regency / City Minimum Wage (MWR). This research uses secondary data and primary data. Secondary data was obtained from the Manpower and Transmigration Office of DIY Province, and then primary data was obtained from survey results in the form of four samples taken from around the Beringharjo Market and Kranggan Market, each with two samples. Based on the data collected, the values of the four samples, namely each sample, there are 60 components of the Decent Living Needs (DLN), then after adding up from each sample they will be calculated using the average formula. The calculation results from this analysis obtained the value of Decent Living Needs (DLN) in 2019 amounting to Rp2,035,489.49 and the Regency/City Minimum Wage in Yogyakarta City amounting to Rp1,846,400.00, of the two values there is a difference between the Decent Living Needs (DLN) of the Regency/City Minimum Wage amount in the City of Yogyakarta amounting to Rp.189,089.49. The conclusion from this analysis is the MWR still lower than the KHL in 2019.
