

ABSTRACT

This study aims to determine the effect of the Proportion of Labor, GRDP, and the Provincial Minimum Wage on the Open Unemployment Rate in the Province of Java Island in 2016-2020. This study uses time series data with a period of 5 years so that it has 30 observations. The type of data used is secondary data sourced from the central statistics agency by province in Jawa. The independent variables used are the proportion of labor, GRDP, and the provincial minimum wage in the Province of Java Island. The analytical tool used is panel data regression, based on the results of the analysis it is known that the proportion of labor variable has no effect on the open unemployment rate, GRDP has an effect on open unemployment rate and the provincial minimum wage has an effect on the open unemployment rate.
