Abstract: The Kamojang geothermal field is located within the Quaternary volcanic complex caldera system (0.452 to 1.2 Ma). The volcanic complex contributes to the formation of vapor-dominated high-temperature geothermal systems (250oC). The potential of the electricity produced from this field was 260 MWe. It is necessary to study the isotope 18O of rock alteration to interpret the geothermal system reservoir conditions in response. This research uses the petrographic analytical method, X-ray diffraction, and isotope 18O and D on some core and cutting samples. Isotope abundances are measured using the measuring method with isotope ratio mass spectrometer (IRMS). Zoning mineral alteration in wells C-1 consisting of the cristobalite-montmorillonite zone, illite-montmorillonite zone, and chlorite-epidote zone. Hydrothermal fluids that generate steam in geothermal systems were derived from meteoric water. These fluids interact with rocks; this was based on an analysis of the ratio of reservoir water-rock interaction wells C-1. The research shows that the value of the fraction oxygen atoms of rocks in the system (1-x) was 0.16. That indicated that the reservoir containing fluid 16% or reservoir is rock dominated. This study is different from previous researchers, namely using 18O isotope analysis of alteration rocks to determine the ratio of rock and fluid in the geothermal reservoir. It is hoped that this method can be used in other geothermal fields.
