

ABSTRACT

This research aims to identify the influence of GRDP, open unemployment rate and district/city minimum wage on poverty in the district/city of D.I Yogyakarta in the period 2013-2023. The analytical tool used in this research is panel data regression, namely a combination of time series data and cross section data. The method used in this research is the Fixed Effect Model method. The data in this research uses secondary data taken through the D.I Yogyakarta Central Statistics Agency. GRDP has a negative and significant effect on poverty, the open unemployment rate has a positive and significant effect on poverty, while the district/city minimum wage has no effect on poverty.
