

## ABSTRAK

Skripsi ini menganalisis implementasi *human security* dalam mengatasi imigran ilegal di Amerika Serikat era Joe Biden tahun 2021-2023. Pergeseran pendekatan dari *state security* menuju *human security* terlihat dari berbagai kebijakan yang menekankan kepatuhan terhadap norma-norma internasional, perlindungan terhadap hak asasi manusia dan keamanan non-tradisional bagi para imigran ilegal. Perbandingan kebijakan imigrasi yang sangat berbeda antara Donald Trump dan Joe Biden tercermin dalam sikap kepemimpinannya dan kondisi imigran ilegal di bawah pemerintahannya. Penelitian ini difokuskan pada kebijakan imigrasi Joe Biden berbasis *human security* tahun 2021-2023. Kerangka pemikiran yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini adalah teori kebijakan imigrasi dari Katharina Natter dan konsep keamanan manusia (*human security*) Laporan Pembangunan Manusia dari UNDP 1994. Metode yang digunakan adalah deskriptif kualitatif, dengan teknik pengumpulan data melalui studi kepustakaan atau *library research* dan melalui dokumen online berupa buku, jurnal, artikel, dan sumber lainnya yang relevan. Dari analisis ini, ditemukan ada beberapa kebijakan presiden Joe Biden yang mengedepankan pendekatan *human security* antara lain, *Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals* (DACA), *Temporary Protected Status* (TPS), *Central American Minors* (CAM), *United States Refugee Admissions Program* (USRAP), dan *Migrant Child Shelter* (MCS).

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*This thesis analyzes the implementation of human security in overcoming illegal immigrants in the United States in the Joe Biden era 2021-2023. The shift in approach from state security to human security can be seen from various policies that emphasize compliance with international norms, protection of human rights and non-traditional security for illegal immigrants. A comparison of the very different immigration policies of Donald Trump and Joe Biden is reflected in their leadership stance and the condition of illegal immigrants under their administration. This research focuses on Joe Biden's immigration policy based on human security in 2021-2023. The framework used in this research is the theory of immigration policy from Katharina Natter and the concept of human security in the 1994 UNDP Human Development Report. The method used is descriptive qualitative, with data collection techniques through library research and online documents in the form of books, journals, articles, and other relevant sources. From this analysis, the author found several policies that apply the human security approach in five policies under the Joe Biden Administration, including Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA), Temporary Protected Status (TPS), Central American Minors (CAM), United States Refugee Admissions Program (USRAP), and Migrant Child Shelter (MCS).*
