The Role of Beef Sufficiency Program (PSDS) Against Revenue Cattle in Wonolelo Village, Subdistrict Pleret, Regency of Bantul. NI MADE SUYASTIRI and BUDIARTO lecturers. The purpose of this study was 1) To analyze the revenue cattle farmers who follow program PSDS with cattle farmers who doesn't program PSDS. 2) To know the implementation of the program PSDS at Ngudi Mulyo group. The method used by the researchers is a survey method. The sampling areas were purposive and the respondents were selected using cencus method, consisting of 35 samples of cattle farmers who participate in PSDS and 25 samples of cattle farmers who doesn't follow PSDS. The analysis technique used is independent t-test sample. The result of independent t-test sample showed that the average revenues cattle who follow program PSDS is Rp 1.383.362,00 higher than the average revenues cattle who doesn't follow program PSDS Rp 732.214,00.
